Call to order

Fisheries: Steve reported he has been in contact with Mike Anderson regarding the completion of the fingerling planting. The balance of what has been paid for to 10,000 Lakes Aquaculture will be planted this spring. Mike Anderson and John Bialozynski are heading up a walleye card deck fundraiser. They are selling ads to businesses to place on a 52 card deck. Star Lake Walleye Fundraiser will be printed on the cards with ads sold to local businesses. The decks will be available for purchase for \$10. Jake made a motion SLPOA donates \$1000.00 towards the fundraiser. Seconded by Steve. Motion passed. Steve reported there has been a decrease in harvesting Walleye county-wide per information from the DNR which has led to considering lowering the Walleye limit.

Buoys in need of replacement were discussed. Steve will research the number of buoys that need to be replaced and will work with JoLene to get a bid for the cost of replacing them.

Sue will be responsible for an AIS article, Steve will check into information on the growth and development of walleye fingerlings for an article. Other suggestions included highlighting Camp Joy's 85th Anniversary, Wake Boat guidelines, and new DNR-proposed Walleye fishing limits.
