
SLPOA Meeting Minutes

Call to order

A meeting of SLPOA was held at 31194 Frog-Trail at 6:30 pm on July 23, 2026. Attendees included JoLene Kerr, Sue Nyhus, Jake Daniels, and Danny Kimball. Steve Roth, Yvette Lewis and Dick Fultz were not present. JoLene Kerr, President, opened the meeting at 6:30 pm.

Approval of minutes

The minutes of the June 25 meeting were presented by Sue Nyhus, Secretary. After reviewing JoLene made a motion to accept and Danny seconded it. The minutes were accepted as presented.

Reports

Treasure: Steve Roth, Treasure was not in attendance. JoLene Kerr, President presented the treasure report. The balances in the accounts were as follows: \$6045.04 in checking; \$18172.99 in the Money Market Fund (Lake Protection). A domain fee bill for \$23.99 was paid to Simple Creations. Mike Anderson's bill for buoy repaid was reimbursed using funds from the Lake Protection fund.

Membership: Jake reported he has received 184 paid memberships as of today. Jake reported he is updating the membership mailing list.

Fisheries: JoLene reported an email was received from Ryan Salberg saying after this season he would no longer be available to manage the buoys he has been taking care of. Sue reported she sent an email to Ryan acknowledging this and thanking him for his years of valuable service. He was asked to contact in the fall when the buoys are in so they can be picked up.

AIS: Sue reported there will be a Rake-Throw to detect invasive species on Friday, July 31 at 9:00 am at the East Landing.

Old Business:

Wake Board Signage: JoLene reported Tag-Up Printing offered to reprint the wake board warning signs with the corrected verbiage at no cost to SLPOA. They have been reposted at the boat landings.

Annual Picnic: Bruce and Linda Christianson and JoLene and Mark Kerr will co-host the picnic at the Christianson's home at 33563 Beaver Dam Trail, Dent. The picnic is on Saturday, August 22 from 12:00-2:00. Two bids were received from Gourmet Smoked Ribs in Moorhead (\$2110.00) and Central Market in Perham (\$1073.73). A motion was made by JoLene to accept Central Market's bid and add cake for dessert. Seconded by Danny. Motion passed. Central Market will provide the food including broasted chicken for 150, two cold salads, rolls, and cake. JoLene will pick up and deliver the food. Water will be available. Sue will send an email invitation to members reminding them to bring a chair and drink of their choice. We have napkins, plates and forks from last year.

Bylaws: Sue reviewed the bylaw saying board meetings will be posted ten days prior to the meeting so that SLPOA members can add items to the agenda and attend the meeting if desired. Sue will post meeting times and locations on the board minutes that are posted on the SLPOA website.

New Business:

2027 Swamp Shark Tournament: Danny reported he has been questioned if the expenses of doing the Swamp Shark Tournament could be reduced such as not having shirts printed so less teams were needed to cover costs. A discussion ensued reviewing costs and scheduling of the tournament. Sue will contact SLPOA members prior to the tournament next year and get member feedback.

Lake Stewardship Program: Jake reported a Lake Steward Program was started for Star Lake. Two Shoreland Guide to Lake Stewardship books were bought for evaluators at the cost of \$16.00. More information will be made available to members about this. A Lake Stewardship evaluation was done by Jake and Sue at the Mark and Lane Magnusson home receiving a high rating as a lake steward. JoLene will check on the cost of signs with Tag-Up Printers.
